



The George Bluebell Walk



A short family walk through bluebell woods. You will see newborn lambs in the adjacent fields as well as alpacas in the field behind the church. Dogs should be kept on the lead throughout this walk. Please don't pick or walk amongst the bluebells so they remain beautiful for others to enjoy.

Follow the path along the edge of the field to the gate on the far side.



Go through the gate and follow the path until you reach the gate to the road (Norton Lane).



Cross over Norton Lane and continue straight ahead along the footpath.

Turn right where the footpath splits into two and follow the path around the field edge to the gate with the woods (Lamberden Wood).



Continue over the bridge over the small stream (North Stream) until you come to a gate to the field. Turn left here and stay in the wood rather than going into the field.



Where the path crosses a small stream bed, turn right and follow the path around the edge of the woods. Look out for new born lambs in the field on the right.



Follow the path until it joins another path with a gate to the field on the right. Turn left back into the woods here.



Follow this path straight on, back across the North Stream and up the hill.



At the top of the hill, continue through the gate and straight ahead.



This path will bring you back to Norton Lane where you retrace your steps back to the churchyard and a well-earned drink at The George.
